
Santa. See Santa's washing drying and a map of his Christmas Eve route at Acorn Bank in Cumbria and get your

BREAKFAST A'A CASTLE

Enjoy early-morning access to this medieval castle, as elves lead the way to the Great Hall. NEXT STOP NORTH POLE

For Polar Express fans, two (non-steam) train trips bring the story alive,

on Weardale Railway, Co Durham, and Dartmoor Railway, Devon. Travelling in pyjamas, children are served hot chocolate and cookies while listening to the story and have their golden tickets punched by

the conductor. At the North Pole, Santa Claus and the elves give

each child a silver bell from Santa's sleigh.
